#### **FUN EVENT FORMAT**

Scores are marked on what you achieve rather than penalties – if you do not like a fence leave it out and carry on! After 3 attempts at any one fence you MUST move on.

If you wish to do the JUMPING PHASES only please put a J on your entry form next to the class number. If you wish to do **DRESSAGE only** put a D after the class number.

Time allowed is generous so there is no need to hurry but marks will be taken off for excessive time taken. The 2 jumping phases are against the clock but time taken will only count if the scores are equal.

**Course Walks** *The course can be walked on Saturday afternoon.* 

Prize Givings will take place at the Gala on Sunday 17 September. These will be dismounted. Dressage sheets will be available on the day after scoring. Final scores will be posted on fb that evening. Rosettes and Championship Trophy will be presented at the Gala. If you are not attending please leave a stamped addressed envelope with the Secretary







## The SDSS is a local Showing Series to encourage entries

into local independent/club shows and give competitors a truly LOCAL final

Qualifying letters/cards given to local independent, or Club shows to hand out in each category (6). If allocated to a Championship / Supreme may be passed down the line to next competitor if winner has already received an invitation in this category.

If allocated to a specific showing class (maybe because the show does not have a suitable Championship) the letters may be passed no further than 3<sup>rd</sup> place (2<sup>nd</sup> if there are 6 or less in the class).

The number of shows taking part are limited so that there should never be an instance where the Final for that category becomes too large even if all those qualifying to take part.

DHS will publicise a list of participating shows on their website and facebook pages and in the Autumn Schedule and endeavour to promote them. Any shows who apply late may miss the hardcopy schedule pages.

Upon receipt of an invitation competitors should fill in their letter and send the relevant part back to the Denmead Show Secretary who will forward you a Finalists badge and box pass in exchange. These will identify you when you come to book in on the day and give you access to the Finalist's tent.

The FINAL will take place during a GALA afternoon at Denmead Autumn Show.

#### **SDSS RULES & CONDITIONS**

- Denmead Horse Show Rules apply on the ground. However, since competitors may have won
  their invitation under a different set of rules, to enable them to take up their invitation, the
  Secretary will waive the rule upon application as long as it does not contravene any Safety
  issues.
- 2. ANY horse/pony winning an invitation to that category may enter a FINAL.
- 3. The FIRST 2 in each Final qualify for the CHAMPIONSHIP
- 4. Shows holding qualifiers must display the fact on the front of their schedules or publish it on their social media they will then receive the letters of invitation
- 5. Finalists must fill in the relevant section of their invitation letter and forward it to Denmead Horse Shows to register their win.
- 6. Dress. Correct showing attire must be worn with the option of Evening Dress for the Gala.
- 7. Competitors qualifying for the Championship during the Gala  $\underline{\text{MUST}}$  stay for the Championship
- 8. It is the Rider / handler / horse combination who qualify in the Final for the Championship. The same combination who qualify in the Final must come forward to the Championship
- Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the Championship a groom may be utilised
  to hold one horse whilst the competitor shows the other, the competitor may then show the
  other.
- 10. Should a competitor qualify a horse for the Championship in more than one Final they must decide which one they are taking up as soon as they take the second qualification ie the Ridden or the In Hand qualification and inform the Secretary so that the unrequired space may be offered to the next in line for the qualification they declined.
- 11. The Championship should be composed of the top 12 competitors from the Finals coming forward.
- 12. Accordingly, those placing 3<sup>rd</sup> in a Final should come forward to the collecting ring before the Championship so they are available should a place NOT be taken up for any reason
- 13. All those in the Championship will receive rosettes / awards / prizes
- 14. The Champion, Reserve & 2<sup>nd</sup> Reserve will also receive sashes & trophies and Bouquets
- 15. Entry Fees: Finals: £10 prepaid. £15 on the day

#### **DENMEAD HORSE SHOWS RULES & CONDITIONS**

- 1 Organisers and landowners will not hold themselves responsible for any accident / injury to any person, animal or property whatsoever or however caused. It is a condition of entry to the showground that all persons agree to indemnify the promoters and landowners against any legal action.
- 2 All Health & Safety Notices / Rules must be followed at all times including safety dress code rulings.
- 3 RESPECT THE OFFICIALS OR BE ASKED TO LEAVE. This applies to all persons entering the Showground.
- 4 Competitors entering classes which may clash do so entirely at their own risk. No entry fees will be refunded unless accompanied by a doctor's or veterinary certificate. THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE AN ENTRY WITHOUT STATING THE REASON.
- 5 Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary within 10 minutes of an incident, together with a £20 deposit which will be refunded if the objection is upheld
- 6 Organisers reserve the right to alter, amalgamate or sub-divide classes should numbers so justify or to substitute other judges for those named. Judges' decisions are final.
- 7 NO galloping / cantering on showground except in arenas / practice area.
- 8 Horses are not allowed in the Spectator only areas.
- 9 Horsewalks & Collecting Rings. Only Competitors & Grooms are permitted in these areas. Please do not stop on a horsewalk.
- 10 CARRIAGES may not be driven on the showground itself unless taking part in a carriage class.
- 11 Novices must have an experienced person with them and not try activities beyond their capabilities.
- 12 Stallions must be handled / in care of experienced persons over 16 years old unless they have applied for and been given a dispensation ahead of time from the Show Director/Secretary. IDHSGB classes must comply with their ruling and be18 years or over.
- 13 Please TAKE YOUR LITTER HOME WITH YOU. Do not muck your horseboxes out onto the ground
- 14 FAMILY ZONE. These areas are near the children's arena(s) where child competitors and their families may watch and wait. Ponies must not go above a walk in these areas and Parents / Responsible Adults are asked to ensure that they are not a danger / liability to anyone else.
- 15 No horse/pony under 4 years of age to be ridden on showground
- 16 Persons engaging in undue use of whip will be asked to leave the showground
- 17 Dress Code.
  - a. Hard hats to the current safety standards must be worn whenever mounted & hair tied back.
  - b. Children taking part in 'in hand' classes must wear their hard hat.
  - c. A rider losing their hat in the jumping arena will be eliminated.
  - d. Correct riding dress must be worn in all ridden classes except Fun classes.
  - At the Fun Shows/classes hats & safe footwear must be worn. Clothes must be neat, tidy & safe but full showing dress is not compulsory.
  - f. Back protectors to current safety standards are advised for jumping classes esp. for children.
  - g. Whips/spurs may not be used in games.
  - h. Tack must be appropriate to the class. Double bridles/reins may not be used in Novice classes.
  - In Fun classes 'everyday' tack may be used. However, Judges may penalise if they feel the rider is relying too much on unusual bitting / tack aids
- 18 Horses/Ponies must not be left tied up & unattended.
- 19 DOGS must be on lead & not left unattended in vehicles in hot weather
- 20 A FRANCHISE to operate on the showground must have been obtained from the organisers in order to carry out <u>any commercial</u> activity, <u>including photography.</u>
- 21 Parking. Parking spaces are limited, please park responsibly and follow stewards instructions. Cars are not permitted in the Lorry lines except for unloading. Competitors parking is usually free however cars left in the Box lines will incur a £20 parking fee. There is a separate area for Competitor's cars.
- 22 CHALLENGE TROPHIES may be collected by the winner, not a representative, from the Trophy tent upon presentation of ID and full details & signature being given. Trophies should be returned by the date specified, if not, FULL COSTS at current rates of replacements will be charged. A small deposit (£20) is required which will be forfeit if they are returned late, to fund a replica for presentation you will still be liable for return of the trophy or full replacement costs and the cost of making good any damage.
- 23 PREPAID Entries close at 10 pm on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday before the show.
- 24 LATE Entries will normally be accepted at the show up until the previous class enters the ring if there is sufficient room. Please check with the Secretary if you are entering very close to start time of the class.
- 25 It is essential that entries are completely filled out and signed that they are happy for the information to be used for show administration. Otherwise, they will NOT be accepted. PLEASE MAKE OUT A SEPARATE ENTRY FOR EACH COMPETITOR. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE REJECTED
